

# Volunteer Information

As you arrive, follow the signs to the volunteer room, and sign in.  
(Please arrive 15 minutes before your time to start and check in at Volunteer table and get your T-shirt.)

**\*\*Note: Please plan to wear your rally t-shirt unless you are a nurse, etc. Also, FYI it gets hot in the maze.**

**\*\* Note 2<sup>nd</sup> Shift: There will be someone to guide you to your room.**

**Food will available to 1<sup>st</sup> shift volunteers arriving between 4 and 5:00 pm. There is pizza available until 7:30 pm. After that there will be snacks and water in the volunteer room and brought to you in the maze.**

Please feel free to go back to the **Volunteer Room** for a **break**, as long as there is enough help at your position.

**Each mazer** should have an Occupation Card with them. You can find out what they have been doing from this. Please direct any confused **mazer to STOP stations or Guides.**

**Also**, make sure that someone in each room is **highlighting any costs** they incur so that the bank will have an accurate tally from the Occupation Card.

**Each room, STOP Station and Guides** will have a **clipboard** with a **color layout, list of consequences and commentary of the maze.**

**Runners for the maze are:**

**Maze Guides** “ASK ME” tags on their name badges and a clipboard with them.

**Refreshment Runners** have blue container with water and snacks

**Storks-** carry “pregnancy bellies” back to the Teen Clinic

**FYI Restrooms** are located in the foyer, so it will be more difficult to get in there.

**Cell Phone** Mazers will be told not to use their cell phones in the maze. If you see this happening please remind them that they will be asked to leave if they continue. Let’ set a good example by not using ours unless it is an emergency. You can go into the volunteer room if you need to.
